#### SCRIPTURE LESSON

John 12:20-33 (The Inclusive Bible)

<sup>20</sup> Among those who had come up to worship at the Passover festival were some Greeks. <sup>21</sup> They approached Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, and put forth this request: "Please, we would like to see Jesus." <sup>22</sup> Philip went to tell Andrew, and together the two went to tell Jesus.

<sup>23</sup> Jesus replied, "Now the hour has come for the Chosen One to be glorified.

<sup>24</sup> The truth of the matter is, unless a grain of wheat falls on the ground and dies, it remains only a single grain; but if it dies, if yields a rich harvest.

<sup>25</sup> If you love your life you'll lose it;

if you hate your life in this world, you'll keep it for eternal life.

<sup>26</sup> Anyone who wants to work for me must follow in my footsteps, and wherever I am, my worker will be there too. Anyone who works for me will be honored by Abba God.

<sup>27</sup> Now my soul is troubled. What will I say: 'Abba, save me from this hour?'

But it was for this very reason that I have come to this hour.

A voice came from heaven: "I have glorified it, and I will glorify it again."

<sup>33</sup> By these words Jesus indicated the kind of death he would die.

In the Gospel of John, there are long addresses by Jesus that seem to be teachings or pronouncements that border on poetry. Perhaps they were sayings or hymns used by the worshiping community to proclaim Jesus' message. The editors of The Inclusive Bible try to distinguish these from the prose of the book by setting them in verse form. In this passage, verses 23-28a, and verses 31-32 are so treated.
