After telling his disciples, "Get up. We're leaving this place." at the end of chapter 14, Jesus goes right on talking (for three more chapters!) until they actually do leave in chapter 18. This has led some to the conclusion that Chapters 15-17 were inserted sometime after the Gospel of John was originally composed. But this is not to say that these chapters are not an authentic tradition regarding the farewell address of Jesus to his disciples. Their inclusion is evidence that the early church found them compelling and helpful to their faith.
