#### SCRIPTURE LESSON

Psalm 23 (The Inclusive Bible)

Your rod and your staff – they give me courage.

The translators of the King James Bible strove to retain a rhythmic and melodic sense of the Psalms, so it is not surprising that for many people who are devoted to this text, any other translation just sounds wrong. But in verse 6, the use of the word "forever" in the King James, is more accurately translated "to the end of days," meaning either "forever," or "for my whole life." In either case, the Psalmist is not worried about the presence of God ever leaving.
